Automating loan application processes

Without EMC's TCM solution, an application in paper format would be routed throughout the organization gathering signatures from several different individuals. That involves overnight mail, faxing, and other forms of transmittal over the course of several days, with possible loss of the application.

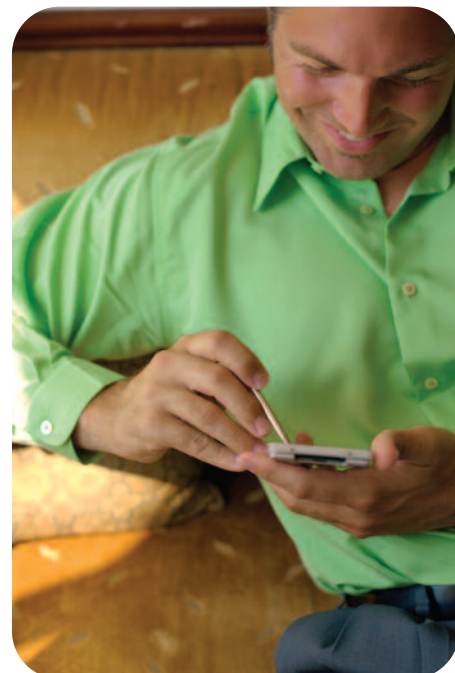

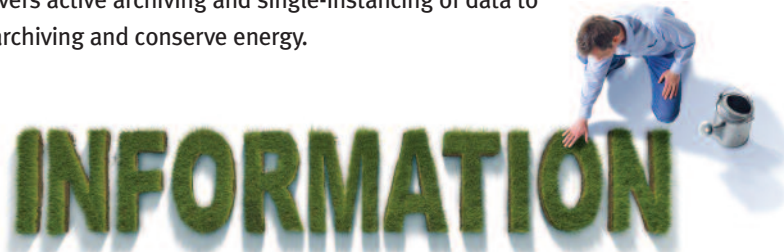
